The urgent care is open from 9:00am – 9:00pm Monday through Saturday, and staffed by experienced Physicians and Certified Physicians, including Casper T. Glenn, M.D.; Magdi Elbassir, M.D.; Christopher Tran, PA-C.; and Anthony Charles Sutton, PA-C. There is no appointment necessary, and all HVVMG HMO members, most PPO plans, Medicare patients, Medi-Medi patients and Cash patients are accepted. Starting January 2, 2011, Heritage Urgent Care will be open 7 days a week, from 9:00am – 9:00pm. The Heritage Baby Program has been going on for the past year, and educates expectant moms on the importance of choosing their child's Pediatrician prior to delivery. As part of the initiative, moms-to-be who sign up with a Heritage physician prior to delivery receive an embroidered Heritage baby blanket and a package of diapers.

Also, a new Senior Wellness Center has recently opened at 15982 Quantico Road, Suite E in Apple Valley, and is an additional resource offered to Heritage members.

The Heritage Conference and Education Center located in The Wimbledon Village at 12370 Hesperia Rd., Suite 13 in Victorville holds the various Doctor Talks, Q & A Sessions, and Support Groups offered by Heritage Victor Valley Medical Group.
